SECTION 1 – TITLE:

This Local Law shall be known as Local Law No. 2 of 2005, a local law repealing Local Law No. 2 of 1999 and repealing Local Law No. 3 of 2003 for the control, confining and leashing of dogs within the Town of Williamstown.

SECTION 2 – PURPOSE:

The Town of Williamstown has adopted Local Law No. 1 of 2005, a local law to be known as the “Dog Control Law” of the Town of Williamstown, and therefore Local Law No. 2 of 1999 and Local Law No. 3 of 2003 are no longer practicable such that a repeal of said laws is now proper.

SECTION 3 – REPEAL OF LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1999:

Local Law No. 2 of 1999 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4 – REPEAL OF LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 2003:

Local Law No. 3 of 2003 is hereby repealed.

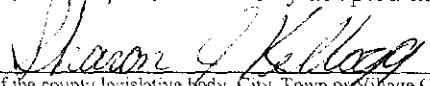

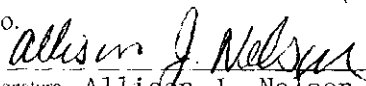
