SECTION 1: TITLE

This shall be known as Local Law 2 of the year 2022, a local law permitting and regulating all-terrain vehicles (ATV) operations on certain public roads of the Town of Williamstown.

SECTION 2: PURPOSE

The purpose of this Local Law is to designate certain town roads in the Town of Williamstown as open for travel by all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) because it has been determined by the Town Board of Williamstown that it is otherwise impossible for ATVs to gain access to areas or trails adjacent to such town roads.

SECTION 3: AUTHORITY

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to the authority contained in New York State Highway Law Section 24050.

SECTION 4: DESIGNATED ROADS

1. The following portions of town roads are hereby designated as open for travel by ATVs.
 - a. Grant Road from ATV Trail (behind Buck's Restaurant) to intersection of State Route 183
 - b. Stone Hill Road from Intersection of State Route 183 to the Amboy/Williamstown Town Line
2. All individuals traveling upon ATVs on roads designated herein shall comply with the following rules and regulations.
 - a. All regulations of New York concerning the operation, registration and inspection and insuring of ATVs shall be followed.
 - b. A maximum speed limit of 25 miles per hour shall be observed.
 - c. ATVs shall not be operated on the designated roads between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
 - d. ATVs shall be no louder than if equipped with stock mufflers.
 - e. Vehicle and Traffic Law regulations concerning driving while under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall be complied with.
 - f. All operators of ATVs on the designated roads shall be at least sixteen years of age.
 - g. Designated roads will be open and closed in compliance with the Oswego County ATV Club riding season dates.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Department of State.
